Suggested Topics

- Advertise items for sale
- Inform readers that the home or lot you personally own in The Springs is for sale
- Share your favorite recipes, photographs, places to visit, etc.

Topics to Avoid

- Inappropriate language and content
- Political views
- Slander
- Complaints about neighbors
- Grievances related to The Springs covenants, rules, regulations, HOA Board, HOA Committees

NOTE: Posts, replies and/or comments which do not meet these requirements will be removed from the Forum.

Posting Tips

- The content, spelling, and grammar of your comments will not be edited and, thus, will be your sole responsibility. An exception, as noted above, inappropriate content may be removed.
- Your first and last name, email address, and the date you published the comment will automatically be added to your post. You may add any additional contact information you wish within the body of the post and/or comment.
- To create a new post, click New Post at the top of the page.
 - Add a subject that clearly identifies the content of the post.
 - o Add your **comments** and optional **media** (images, photos, other documents) you wish to insert.
 - Click Preview to double check your work. This gives you the opportunity to see exactly how your post will appear on the Off the Cuff page.
 - Click Publish (the blue, rectangular box on the right side of the page).
 - To schedule your post for a future date: edit the date on the top right of the page in the Publish section.
- To comment on an existing post, click on *Comments* below the active post, and "Leave a Reply."
- To comment on a comment, click on Reply.
