Overnight Mooring Privileges & Regulations

- Four slips at Dock 2 and four at Dock 3 are available for overnight mooring use by Property Owners in good standing from May through October for \$100/month.
 - Assignments of slips will be for a period of up to one calendar month. These slips will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis unless demand exceeds the eight slips. In that case, a lottery method of assignment will be used for allocation. Once the usage period is complete, the Property/watercraft Owner must remove the watercraft. That Property/watercraft Owner may rejoin the “overnight mooring request list” after all other eligible Property/watercraft Owners requesting overnight mooring privileges have had an opportunity to use these slips. If Property/watercraft Owners do not remove their watercraft in a timely manner, The Springs HOA Board may have it removed at the owner’s expense.
